Note: TIP Amendment requests that require air quality conformity re-determination and/or a Regional Transportation Plan Amendment (“Plan Amendment”) may take longer to process than indicated by the schedule. TIP Amendment requests that meet either of those conditions will be amended into the TIP after the conformity determination and/or the Plan Amendment is complete.

¹ Amendment requests are due by 5:00 pm to the NFRMPO Office on the first business day of each TIP Amendment cycle.

² The 30-day Public Comment period opens when the next TAC meeting packet is released, one week prior to the TAC meeting.

³ The dates identified for opening the Public Comment period, TAC Recommendation, Planning Council Adoption, and closing the Public Comment period are based on TAC and Council meetings scheduled as of February 23, 2017. If a TAC or Council meeting is cancelled, the TIP Amendment will be brought to the next scheduled meeting and the TIP Amendment cycle will be extended.

⁴ The January TIP Amendment cycle was processed using the FY 2016-2019 TIP policies and procedures, which included two additional steps not displayed in the table: TAC Discussion and Council Discussion.

⁵ Amendment requests received by March 1 will go to TAC for recommendation in April due to the cancellation of the March TAC meeting.
