UPDATES	Senior Travel Training Program – Traveling Training continues to go well.  Larimer County Senior Transportation – The Larimer County Mobility Committee gave a letter of support for the Larimer County Transit Planning 4 All grant application.

## **Discussion Items**

LARIMER COUNTY SENIOR TRANSPORT STUDY	The Transit Planning 4 All grant was submitted and confirmed, and the County should hear back before June 1. The study is on hold until confirmation about the grant is received. The County is expected to use the grant for planning purposes then use Commissioner's funding for implementation.
PAFC COMMUNITIES MISSION AND VISION	The STC is the Mobility and Access Priority Group for Larimer County's PAFC. The PAFC group needs to put together a Strategic Plan regarding increasing accessibility for older adults in the future. Need to assess what is happening in Larimer County – what are the existing services and connections? Where are the gaps?
REGIONAL TRANSIT AND TRANSPORT OPTIONS	The group used the Larimer County Answers on Aging Resource Guide and the NFRMPO Rider's Guides to discuss the regional transit and non-transit transportation options available. Many of these agencies collaborate to improve service and fill in gaps where they exist. Gaps include rural transportation, travel between cities, paratransit between cities, hours of operation, distances from bus stops to destinations, capacity limits on volunteer services, and the perceptions about transit and driving as a senior.
