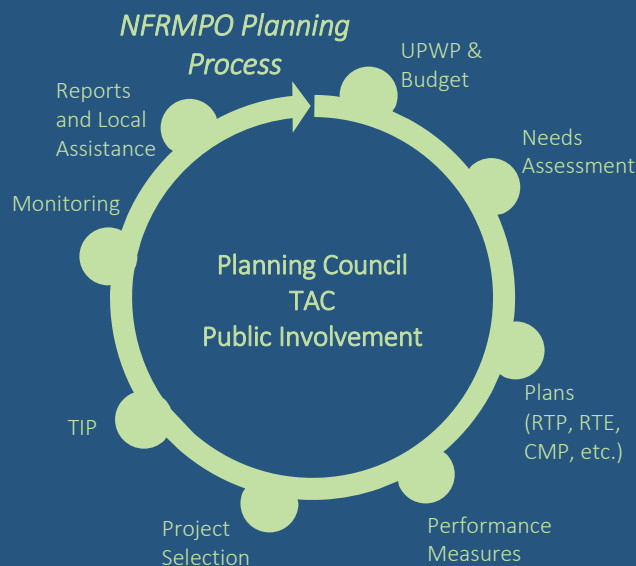

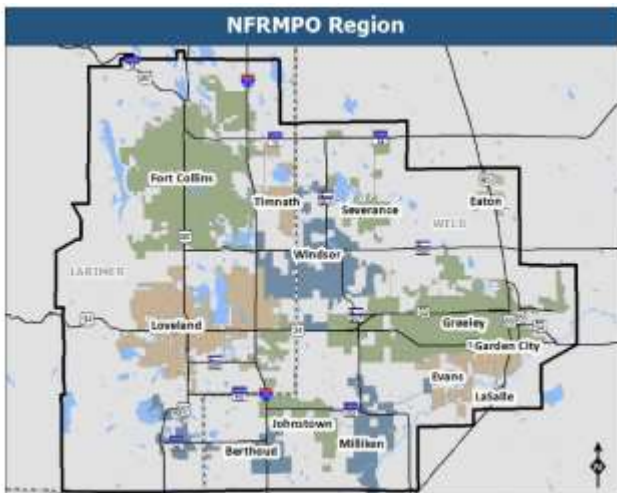

# North Front Range Metropolitan Planning Organization (NFRMPO)

- Transportation and Air Quality Planning agency formed in 1988 and expanded to current borders in 2007
- Federally designated Transportation Management Area (TMA) (based on urbanized area populations of 200,000 or more)
- Covers 675 square miles with over 480,000 residents
- One representative from each member agency serves on the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and the Planning Council, including:
  - Berthoud
  - Eaton
  - Evans
  - Fort Collins
  - Garden City
  - Greeley
  - Johnstown
  - Larimer County (part)
  - LaSalle
  - Loveland
  - Milliken
  - Severance
  - Timnath
  - Weld County (part)
  - Windsor
- Funded through federal, state, and local government sources including Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grants.



# MPO Responsibilities

## Transportation Planning

- Congestion Management Process (CMP)\*  
*adopted September 2015*
  - Plan and process to reduce regional transportation congestion; updated in conjunction with the RTP
- Freight Northern Colorado (FNC)  
*under development*
  - Long-range vision plan for regional freight services
- Public Involvement Plan (PIP)\*  
*adopted November 2015*
  - Guide to future public involvement for all MPO planning efforts
- Regional Non-Motorized Plan  
*adopted February 2017*
  - Inventory and future plans for pedestrian and bicycle facilities in Northern Colorado
- Regional Transit Element (RTE)  
*adopted August 2015*
  - Long-range vision plan for regional transit services
- Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)\*  
*adopted September 2015; amended February 2017 and June 2017*
  - Fiscally constrained plan for transportation projects and planning with 25-year outlook; updated every four years
- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)\*  
*adopted July 2017*
  - Fiscally constrained listing of transportation projects programmed using Federal, State, and Local funds over the next four years
- Transportation Profile  
*completed August 2017*
  - Snapshot of current transportation system updated every four years
- Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)\*  
*adopted May 2017; amended September 2017*
  - Specific planning tasks, projects, and studies MPO staff will undertake in the next one-to-two years

## Air Quality

- Travel Demand and Land Use Modeling
- Air Quality Conformity
- Coordination with the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG), Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment - Air Pollution Control Division (CDPHE-APCD) and the Regional Air Quality Council (RAQC)

## Regional Collaboration

- Planning Council
  - Comprised of elected officials from 15 member communities and a representative from the Transportation Commission of Colorado and CDPHE-APCD.
- Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)
  - Comprised of technical staff of 15 member communities, local transit providers, CDOT, FHWA, RAQC, and the NoCo Bike & Ped Collaborative
- NoCo Bike & Ped Collaborative
  - Committee to coordinate and implement the Non-Motorized Plan, share information, and discuss funding opportunities
- Participation in local planning studies and coalitions

## Mobility Coordination

- Coordinated Public Transit / Human Services Transportation Plan\*  
*adopted December 2017*
  - Guides the Larimer and Weld Mobility Committees' annual work plans and the work of MPO staff with the goal of ensuring transportation self-sufficiency for all individuals in the region
