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Discussion I tems

LARIMER COUNTY	Alex discussed the Senior Transportation Work Group has been working on a grant application for FTA Section 5304 to develop an Implementation Plan. Katy discussed the group is planning to apply for another grant from Transit Planning 4 All.							
SENIOR TRANSPORTATI ON NEEDS								
REPORT UPDATE	Katy stated there was a Board of County Commission work session to discuss the Needs Assessment next step. There was good feedback from the Commissioners.							
2045 RTE	Alex discussed the 2045 Regional Transit Element. The group requested the NFRMPO look into how to help communities outside of the big cities; compare changes in the transit system to what it was in the past; and to look into if the COLT Commuter Route has already begun.							
STC AND ADVOCACY	At previous meetings, the group had discussed what STC and its members is allowed to do. The group should set a policy for the group that respects the restrictions of members. PAFC cannot lobby because it is a non-profit. The group should ask PAFC about advocacy and its policy – is STC allowed to educate?							
OUTREACH TEAM	STC will be doing outreach in the form of City Plan outreach and looking into a transportation fair.							
TRAVEL TRAINING UPDATE	Anna stated there were over 800 participants in 2017. She is meeting with COLT and Chilson Senior Center staff to discuss travel training. Stuff the Bus was a successful event — a Transfort bus was set up in Fort Collins to accept donations, specifically gear for homeless individuals. Anna stated Transfort has a Ride Assist program and Veyo applied for the funding.
