









Re: CDOT/Local Agency IGA Process Feedback

Background

CDOT is requesting feedback on the CDOT/Local Agency IGA process from the five Colorado MPOs to better understand any issues in the process and provide support where possible. The NFRMPO is assisting CDOT by compiling information from local agencies on any IGA process issues.

Action

Staff requests local agencies contact Medora Bornhoft by **Wednesday, December 23** to provide the following information for any projects experiencing issues with the CDOT/local agency IGA process:

- Project name
- IGA status (outline agreement with CDOT for review/signatures, outline agreement with local agency for review/signatures, etc.)
- When the next project phase is starting
- Known issues prohibiting the project from moving forward, if any (e.g. disagreement on local match amount, reimbursement rate, maintenance or environmental responsibilities, etc.)
