3. Public Comment (2 minutes each)

No public comments were received.

4. Approval of May 2022 Meeting Minutes

Fletcher-Carter motioned to approve the May minutes. Solesbee seconded the motion, and it was approved unanimously.

PRESENTATION

1) LinkNoCo Update – Gordon

Gordon gave a presentation about LinkNoCo, the NFRMPO Premium Transit Analysis for the region. Deliverables from this project includes a corridor evaluation, finance and government plan, and a premium transit analysis implementation recommendation. This project has included several types of community outreach: surveying, an online open house, a project website, and community presentations.

This project started with 17 corridors based on the 2045 Regional Transit Element and local plans, and through the public engagement process, three priority corridors were highlighted. These include Fort Collins to Greeley, Loveland to Windsor, and Loveland to Greeley. Gordon shared specific details about each route as included in the slides attached. Fletcher-Carter notes that connecting Berthoud and other nearby communities to the new Berthoud mobility hub on I-25.



Gordon notes that next steps include plan writing, draft plan review to NFRMPO Technical Advisory Council (TAC) and the NFRMPO Planning Council. Slides for this presentation are attached.

RIDENOCO UPDATES

Schmitt gave an update about RideNoCo, including the following updates:

- 1) Sheereen Ibtesam is serving a year as the AmeriCorps VISTA Outreach Specialist. Started last month in June 2022.
- 2) The Trip Discovery Tool is in its final stages of development. Schmitt demonstrated the draft Trip Discovery Tool
 - a. Fletcher-Carter asked how time was calculated. Schmitt shared that it was based on an algorithm from Open Street Map and Open Street Planner.
- 3) Trip Scheduling Steering Committee outcomes and next steps
- 4) Provider's Guide update email coming soon

ANNOUNCEMENT

- 1) **CDOT Call for Projects Open** – Schmitt/All
Capital and Operating Funds CDOT applications opened in July. Reach out to Schmitt with any questions.
- 2) **Fare Free Transit Month** – Schmitt/Smith
Free for the month of August as funded by SB-180 to combat Ozone pollution. COLT has been approved for both fixed and paratransit service. Transfort is already fare free. GET is applying, too. Bustang is half off through Labor Day weekend. Mumma asked where to find more information about this initiative; he would like to share more information with his partners.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 1) **Shared Resource Library** – Johnson/ All
Johnson shared updates regarding the Shared Resource Library. Based on feedback from LCMC and WCMC, a “terms of use” agreement was drafted that the group reviewed together. - iv. Research various medical clinics (eye clinics, for example) in region
- v. Research contacts working for smaller communities like Timnath to see if they would like to engage in Mobility Committee activities

2) Outreach and Education Working Group – Johnson/ All

a. Next Steps:

- ii. Get brochures from VA Hospital partners and distribute
- iii. Work with partners to go to reoccurring outreach opportunities like the Red Feather Lakes Food Bank program on Fridays

TRANSFORT & COLT NEWS AND UPDATES

- I. Smith announced that COLT has added Route 6 and will reroute Route 3 to the new VA hospital; Route 5 will also have substantial changes. COLT's Paratransit will expand with these changes.

LCMC MEMBER UPDATES

- I. Fletcher-Carter announced that the Berthoud Fire Protection District has notified RAFT and Berthoud Senior Services that they can no longer host their offices in their building. RAFT is now exploring where to host their office as they have 90 days until having to leave the Berthoud Fire Protection District building. Kaliczak has a useful moving checklist she can share with Fletcher-Carter.

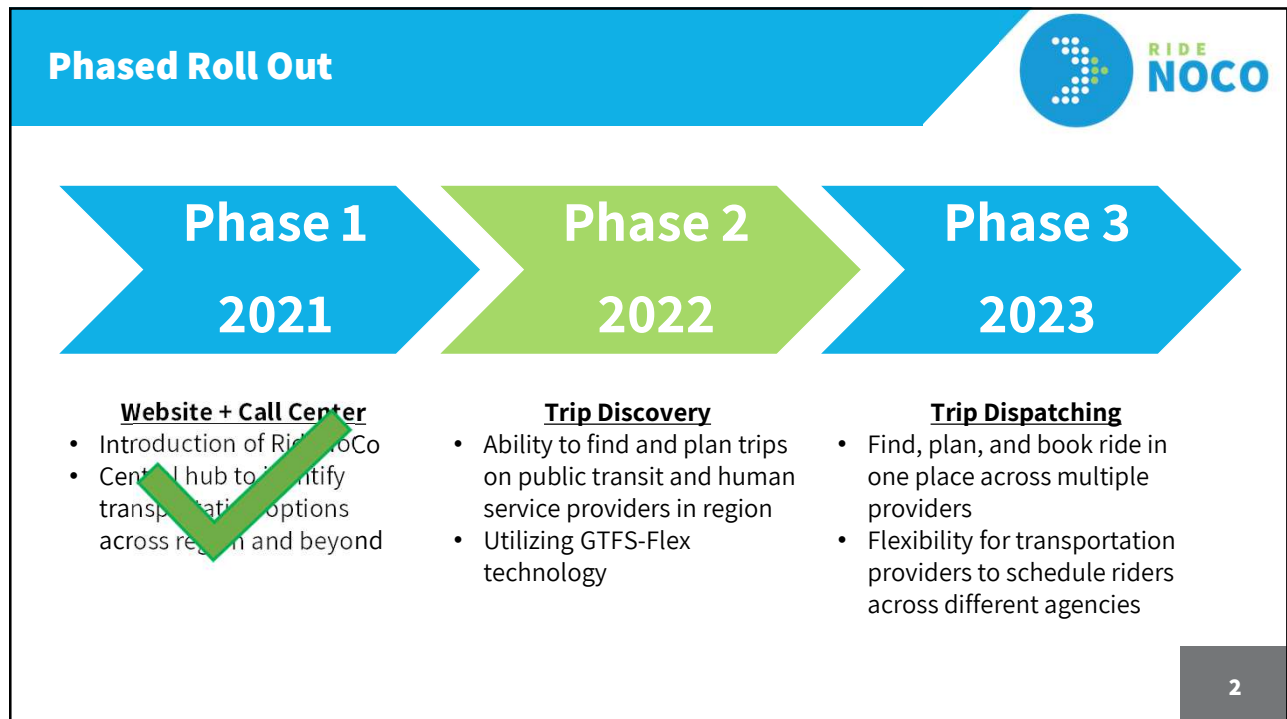

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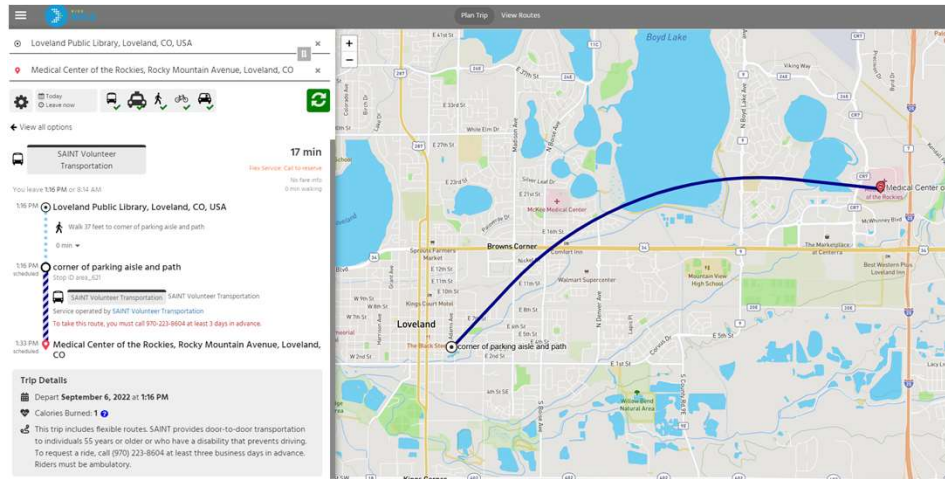


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Phase 2: Trip Discovery Tool



- How should volunteer providers be represented?



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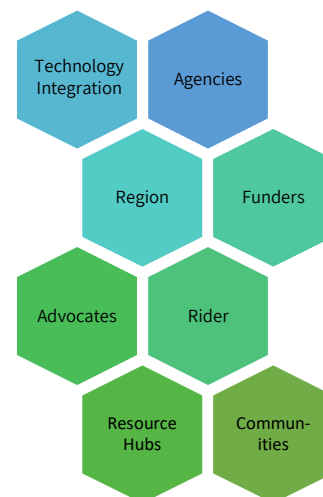
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Phase 3: Trip Scheduling Steering Committee



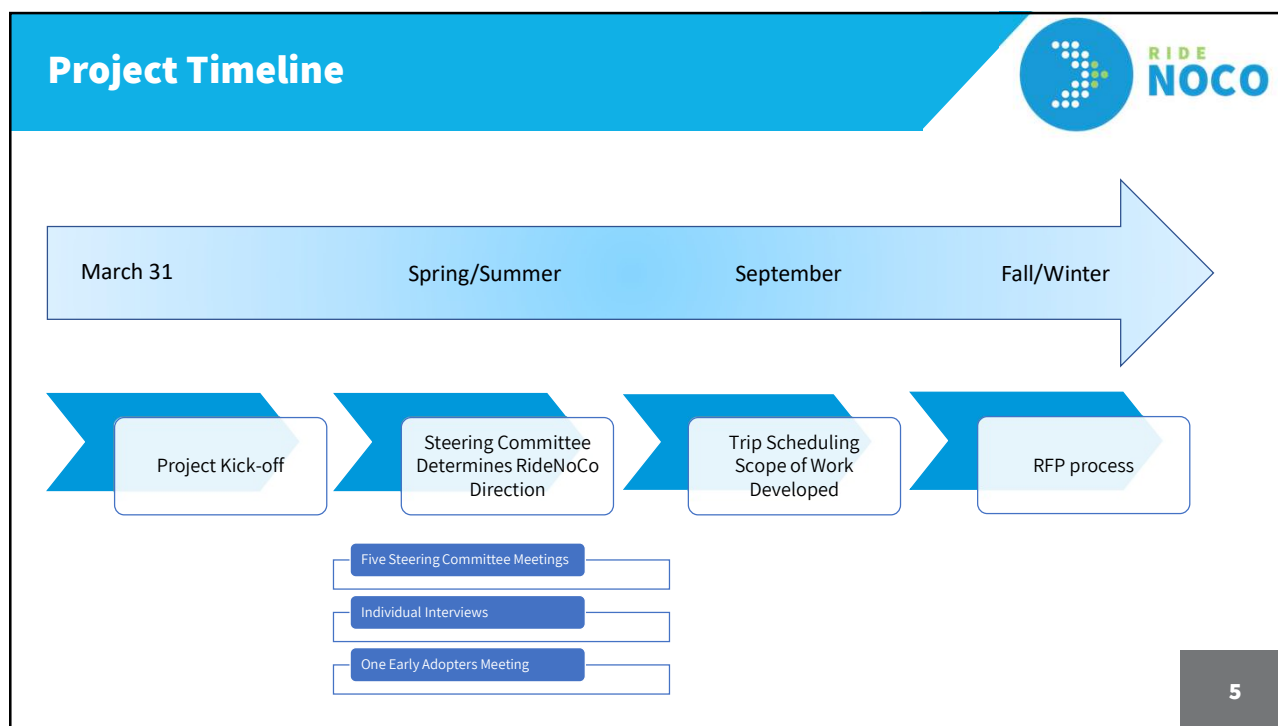
- Purpose:** Guide the implementation of the Trip Scheduling Software component of RideNoCo by determining agency and regional technology needs, capacity, and software functionality

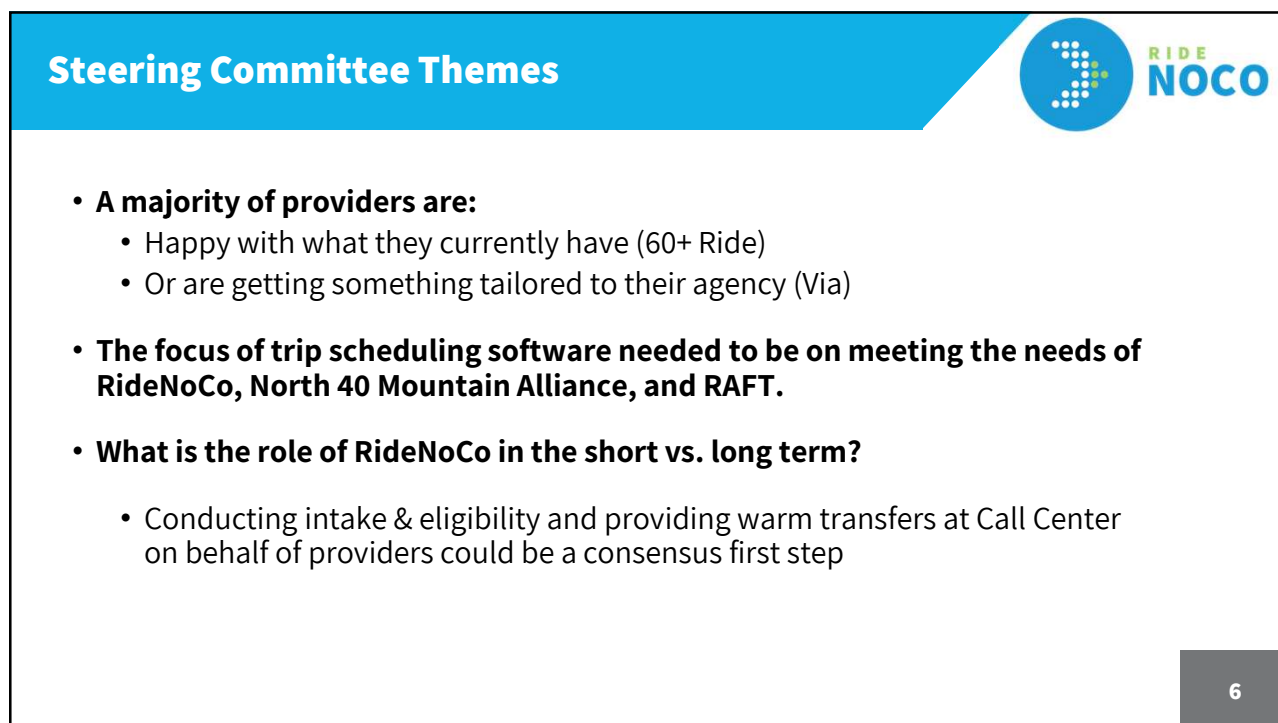


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Phase 3: Next Steps



- **Transactional Data Specifications (TDS)** lay the foundation for ease of coordination in the future
 - The NFRMPO plans to work with 2 volunteer transportation software vendors currently used by local providers to make platforms TDS compliant
- RideNoCo will procure **RideSheet** as a TDS-compliant Customer Relationship Management (CRM) platform.
 - RideSheet is an open-source scheduling platform utilizing Google Sheets developed with funding from AARP

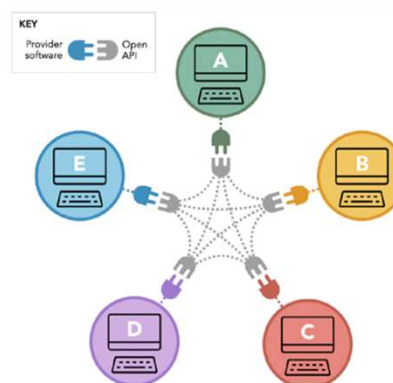
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Phase 3: Next Steps Continued
