MEETING NOTES	No comments.
ONE CALL/ONE CLICK CENTER UPDATES	<p>Schmitt provided an update on RideNoCo including updates on the trip discovery tool, the trip scheduling steering committee, and introduced Sheereen as AmeriCorps Outreach Specialist.</p> <p>Mason asked if rider's would have to contact provider to schedule rides or if there would be a portal to request rides. Schmitt answered that some agencies already have software that allows riders to request rides without calling, but that decision would continue to lie with providers at this time.</p>

## Discussion Items

MIDTOWN FORT COLLINS WALK AUDIT	Schmitt presented the <a href="#">Arc StoryMap</a> on Walk Audit. 20 participants participated in the Walk Audit and provided feedback on the current built environment of the Midtown Fort Collins/Foothills Mall area. Pedestrian experience documented though NFRMPO Bike & Pedestrian Safety Reporter tool.
FALL WORKSHOP: HEALTHCARE & TRANSPORTATION ROUNDTABLE	<p>Mason mentioned difficulty in finding specific contacts in medical systems to even plan these conversations but suggested reaching out to PAFC Board Member Alan Heileman who worked for Aspen Club, affiliated with UC Health.</p> <p>Schmitt said vision of these roundtables were to start a dialogue between transportation and medical providers about the transportation needs of patients with the goal of creating a toolkit that can be replicated in other communities and medical centers.</p> <p>Baker said early morning and lunch were usually the best time to get in front of medical staff and to always include food.</p> <p>Nelson-Cleverley said SAINT would be interested in participating.</p>
WELD COUNTY	Schmitt mentioned that a Transportation Committee is starting in Weld County as

Schmitt said United Way of Weld County doing job of getting the right partners to the table.</p>

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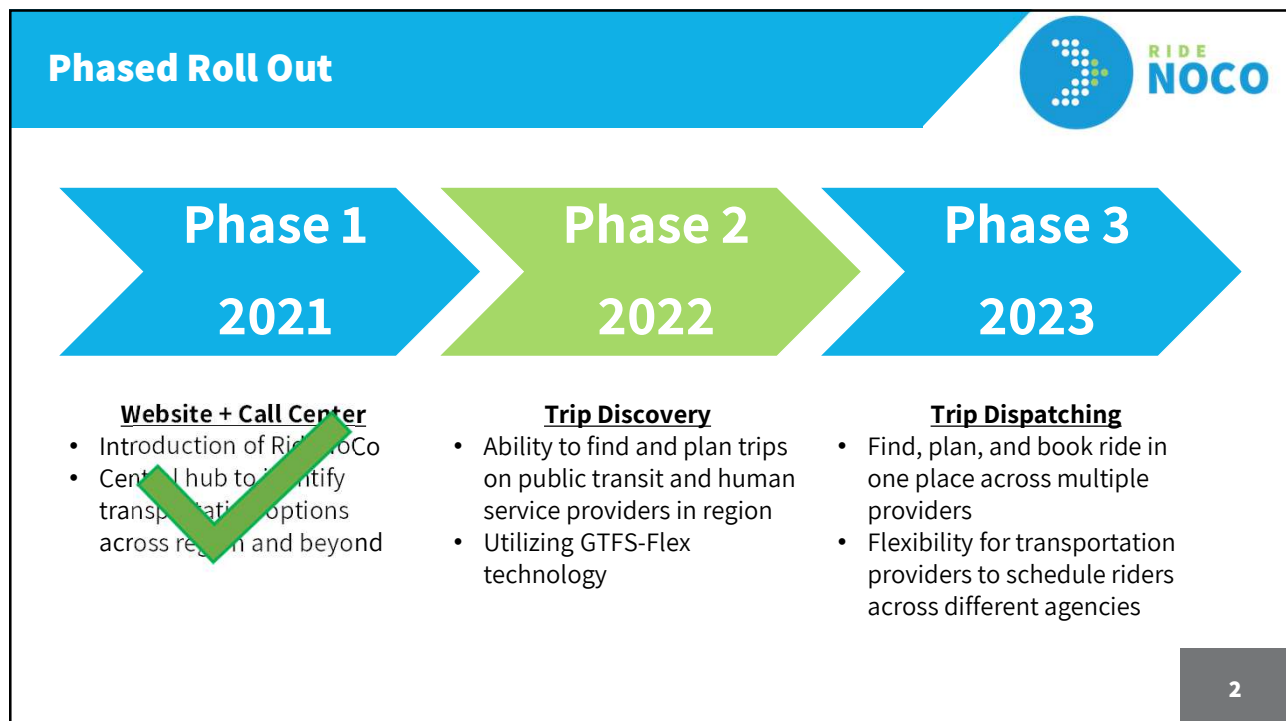

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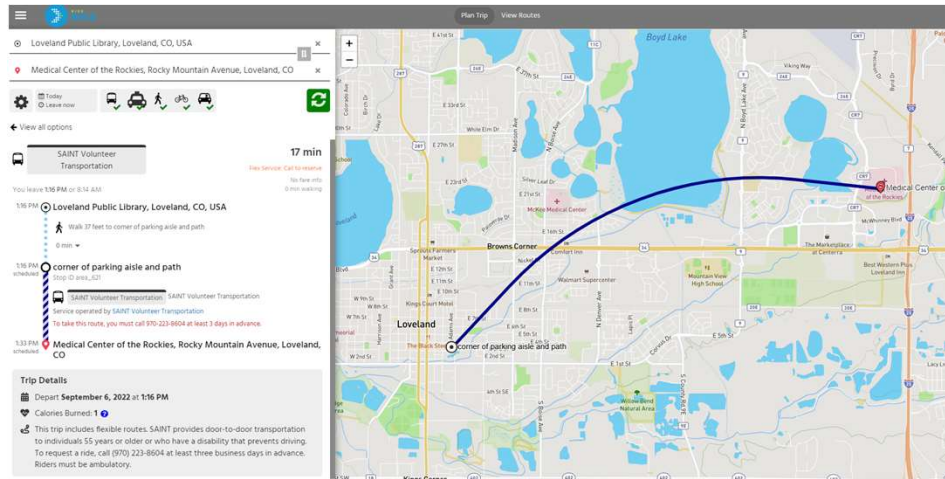


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## Phase 2: Trip Discovery Tool

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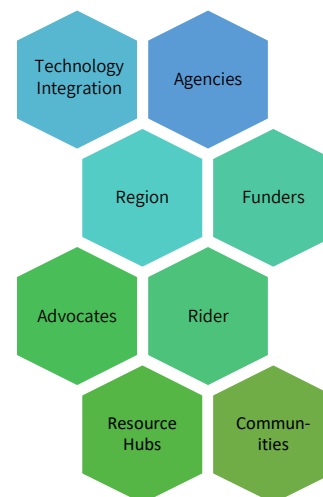
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## Phase 3: Trip Scheduling Steering Committee



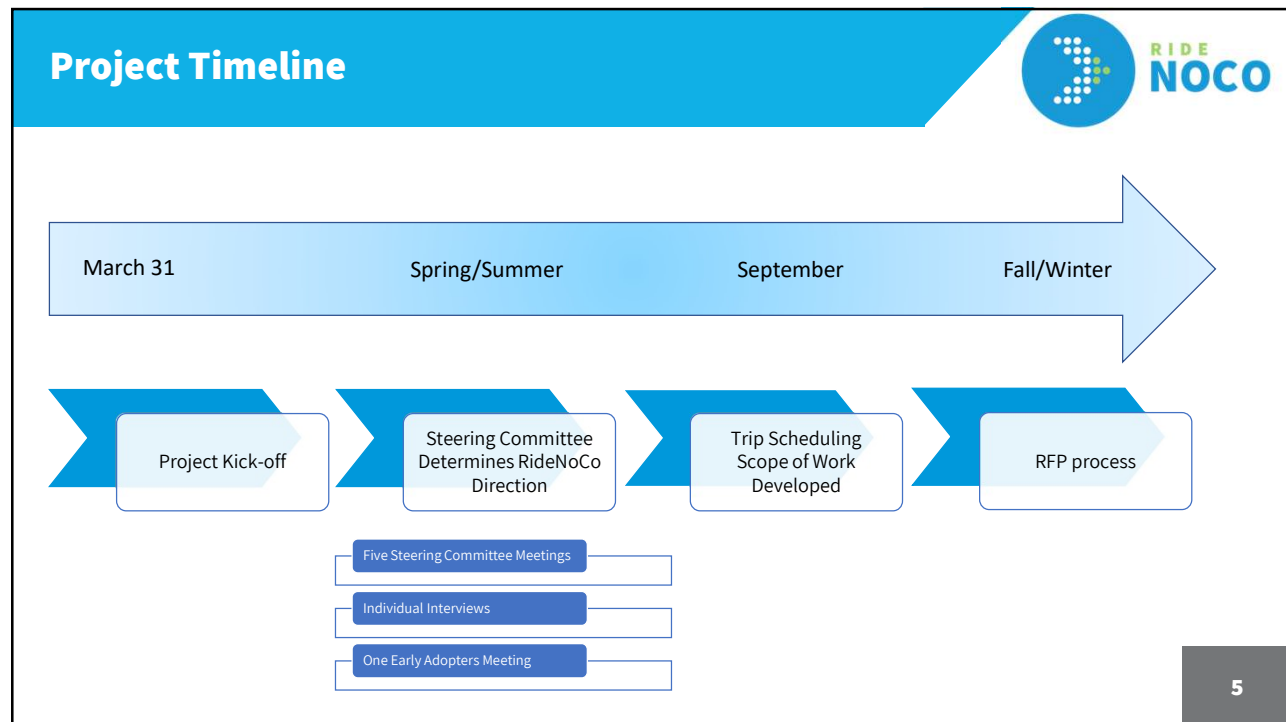
- Purpose:** Guide the implementation of the Trip Scheduling Software component of RideNoCo by determining agency and regional technology needs, capacity, and software functionality

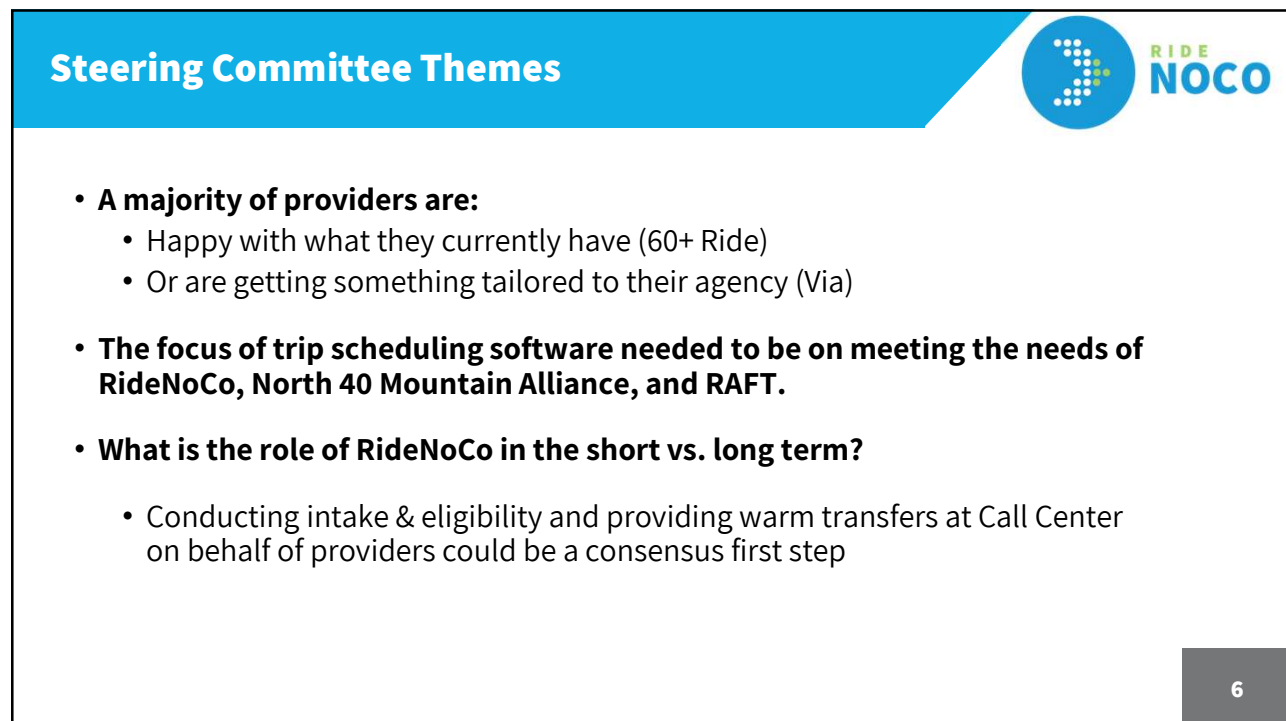


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## Phase 3: Next Steps



- **Transactional Data Specifications (TDS)** lay the foundation for ease of coordination in the future
  - The NFRMPO plans to work with 2 volunteer transportation software vendors currently used by local providers to make platforms TDS compliant
- RideNoCo will procure **RideSheet** as a TDS-compliant Customer Relationship Management (CRM) platform.
  - RideSheet is an open-source scheduling platform utilizing Google Sheets developed with funding from AARP

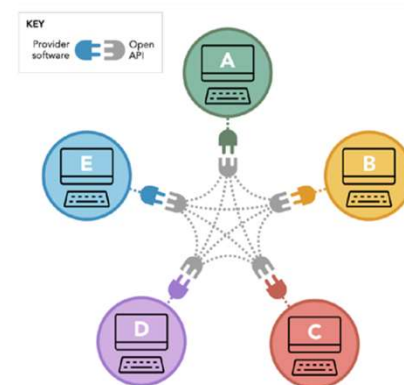
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## Phase 3: Next Steps Continued

  1. Provide funding for small, non-profit transportation providers who have or adopt TDS-compliant software platforms
    - Funding available currently
  2. Provide funding support for larger public and non-profit transportation providers in Northern Colorado to implement TDS-compliant software
    - Funding support may be part of a later application
