

Discovery Tool has officially launched! This tool allows people in Northern Colorado to find a variety of transportation options and plan trips across the region. A major goal of this project was to add volunteer transportation providers and smaller agencies such



as 60+ Ride, RAFT, SAINT, and BATS to an online trip planner.

<u>GFTS-Flex</u> databases were built to include these agency's service areas, eligibility criteria, scheduling details, and contact information. Additionally, this project leveraged existing <u>GTFS</u> data from transit agencies across and beyond Northern Colorado including Greeley-Evans Transit, Transfort, City of Loveland Transit (COLT), Estes Transit, Via Mobility Services, RTD, CDOT's Bustang, and even the Rocky Mountain National Park Shuttle. The inclusion of volunteer transportation providers alongside public transit providers is a first of its kind in the United States for a trip planning tool.

# 2022 Northern Colorado Mobility Accomplishments

2022 was a busy year for the NFRMPO Mobility Team and partners in Northern Colorado! A few key accomplishments include:

- Created a Regional Mobility Action Plan (MAP) to implement the strategies
  established by the 2021 Coordinated Plan
- Substantial completion of the Trip Discovery Tool
- Completion of the work of the Trip Scheduling Steering Committee to guide Phase 3 of the RideNoCo rollout
- Envision transportation funding support via FTA 5310 funds
- 60+ Ride van and funding support via CDOT and Weld County
- Via Mobility Services obtained funding to return to rural Weld County in 2023
- Travel training event with the Immigrant and Refugee Center of Northern Colorado in partnership with GET, 60+ Ride, and RideNoCo
- Completed 2 walk audits that incorporated the NFRMPO's <u>Bike & Ped Safety</u> <u>Reporter</u> Tool and the Larimer County Public Health and Environment's Walk Audit Toolkit
- 4500+ Riders Guides distributed regionally
- Worked with United Way of Weld County and other partners to develop the transportation component of the Weld County AARP Age Friendly Action Plan

## Northern Colorado Mobility Committee and 2023 Meeting Calendar



Since 2021, the Weld County and Larimer County Mobility Committees have emphasized the need for a platform to discuss regional mobility issues by meeting as a Joint Mobility Committee; meeting once in 2021 and then twice in 2022. At the October 2022 Joint Mobility Meeting, the WCMC and LCMC collectively decided to begin meeting quarterly in 2023 as a Northern Colorado Mobility Committee to continue investing time on regional mobility topics and creating cross-jurisdictional

networks to address the mobility needs of our Northern Colorado communities.

Additionally, the Partnership for Age-Friendly Communities of Larimer County's (PAFC) Mobility & Access Priority Group has formally decided to fold into the Larimer County Mobility Committee beginning in January 2023. Due to these changes, the 2023 Mobility Meeting Calendar will differ from previous years as noted below:



In 2023, each committee will meet once a quarter, on the fourth Tuesday of that month as follows:

- Larimer County Mobility Committee meets in January, April, July, and October on the fourth Tuesday from 1:30 to 3:00 PM
- Weld County Mobility Committee meets in March, June, September, and December on the fourth Tuesday from 1:30 to 3:00 PM
- Northern Colorado Mobility Committee meets in February, May, August, and November on the fourth Tuesday from 1:00 to 3:30 PM
