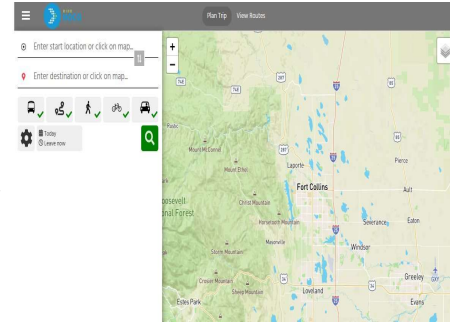

## Trip Discovery Tool Update



- **RideNoCo Trip Discovery Tool** is being changed to just the **MyWayToGo** tool
  - Maintaining own tool cost increase compared to **MyWayToGo** cost
  - Complaints of inefficient routes/suggestions, and not reliable or up-to-date information
  - Unable to collect data on usage or how many people use it
- **MyWayToGo** allows for commuting and one-way trips
  - Allows for different pooling options
  - Can run challenges, events, point systems, and incentives
  - Easier for regional messaging to use one tool and push to one tool
  - Not to compete with commonly used mapping tools
- **MyWayToGo** is also updating its website and information
  - Will have their own App
  - Getting rid of their own mapping system to utilize Googles
  - Will have better mapping and more efficient routes
  - The search ribbon for websites will be gone with the update

## Call Meeting to Order, Welcome, and Overview of Agenda

### Public Comment

There was no public comment.

### Approval of the June Meeting Minutes

Ty Lamb moved to approve the June 24, 2025, meeting minutes, which Adriana Torres seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

### Co-Chair Elections

Aaron Hull explained that Nicole Seward had to step down from being a Co-Chair. Aaron explained the responsibilities of the Co-Chair position to the group. Hull opened it up to the group for discussions and nominations. He also mentioned that you can email him with nominations. Steve Teets mentioned nominating Robin Blakely with 60+Ride as a co-chair.



## Virtual Meeting

Aaron will reach out to see if she is interested in this position. Hanna will also consider Trevor Trepanier as a potential nominee for the position.

Aaron will send out an email with the co-chair description and bylaws, request nominations by Oct. 31st, and bring it back for the Committee's consideration at the December meeting.

## RideNoCo Update

Hull provided an update on the call center, sharing year-to-date call and website visit statistics, as well as discussing upcoming outreach events. Year-to-date, there have been 260 calls and 4,668 website visits.

The data indicates that more people are calling from Larimer County than from Weld County. Hanna offered to share resource contact information to help RideNoCo make more connections in Greeley, thereby facilitating more outreach to Weld County residents. Aaron will provide the year-to-year statistic comparison between the counties for the next meeting.

Steve also recommended sharing a RideNoCo pamphlet with libraries, bus facilities, social services, and community senior centers.

NFRMPO staff have done 35 event presentations so far this year.

Steve had a question about whether a representative from the City of Evans would be willing to participate in the Mobility Committee. Aaron will follow up and reach out to Evans.

## Presentations

### Greeley Mobility Development Plan

Hanna Feldmann, City of Greeley Transportation Planner, presented the Mobility Development Plan to the Mobility Committee. The Greeley City Council adopted the Plan in May of 2025.

Routes 1 and 5 are focusing on Bus Rapid Transit (BRT).

The short-term priority is to provide a shuttle service to UC Greeley Hospital.

She noted the Greeley bus route system has not been updated since 2001, so this plan recommends significant route updates.

Additionally, Greeley aims to continue collaborating with Evans to develop a future mobility hub in their community, located near Envision and the Community Center.

GET is also conducting a rebranding effort to capture better the expanded mobility services, including the opportunity to participate in naming the new US 34 Transit Service.



## Virtual Meeting

Steve invited Hanna to attend the next Citizen Bus Advisory Group and WAND meetings to share her presentation with both groups and bring hard copies of surveys to gather as much resident and user feedback as possible.

Steve then asked Hanna to define the term micromobility transit. She stated that it refers to scooters, bicycles, and on-demand transit services that help connect users to shared bus stops and bike lanes.

Steve also wanted to know what the definition of first and last mile transit means. Feldmann explained it, referring to the distance from your house to the bus stop, which equals your first mile. The last mile refers to the distance between where the stop ends and your destination, such as your workplace or employment location. Greeley's Plan outlines the various strategies available to achieve both scenarios. More specifically, Greeley's Plan outlines how the city is connecting a neighborhood to the community hub, and ultimately to a regional hub.

## Wrap-Up & Member Updates

### Greeley Evans Transit News & Updates

Trevor updated the group on the progress of GET, the completion of the Ride 3 program, and the finalization of grants. They are in the process of transferring CMAQ funds back to CDOT. Also, they are evaluating other grant opportunities to leverage additional funding for a new operations center to accommodate GET's expanding fleet.

### WCMC Member Updates & Roundtable

Aaron is completing TMO Guidebook updates for the next TAC meeting in October and Council in November.

Aaron also mentioned the CASTA Conference and will compile a slide summarizing the conference highlights for the next meeting.

Steve had an update on the changes in Medicare and Medicaid for next year and wants to ensure people are aware of the changes.



## Virtual Meeting

Ty Lamb said he hosted a Collective Impact Community Listening Event on July 31<sup>st</sup> from 1:00 to 3:00 pm and will be hosting the final public meeting at Farr Library in October.
